INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO THE FERTILISERS AND CHEMICALS TRAVANCORE LIMITED (FACT)

The Ernakulam Branch of SICASA of ICAI conducted an industrial visit to The Fertilisers and Chemicals Travancore Limited (FACT) on the 18th of November 2023. This meticulously organized excursion provided the students with an invaluable opportunity to witness firsthand how a factory operates and the practical applications of auditing concepts we've garnered within the walls of our classrooms.

The Fertilisers and Chemicals Travancore Limited (FACT) was incorporated in the year 1943 as the first large-scale fertilizer plant Udyogamandal, Kerala. FACT started Kochi, production in 1947. Initially in the Private Sector, FACT became a Public Sector company in 1960 and the Government of India became the major shareholder in 1962. Over the years, FACT has grown far and wide and now stands as one of the biggest fertiliser enterprises of the country, specializing in the production of Ammonia, NPK, Sulphuric Acid, Caprolactam and FACTAMFOS.

The excursion of 23 students was flagged off from the ICAI Bhawan at Diwan's Road at 9:30 AM and we were joined by the SICASA Chairman, CA Tonny Varghese. Upon arrival at the Factory by 10:45, we were warmly welcomed by the FACT team, who briefed us on the factory's key operations and provided us with essential safety gear, thus setting the stage for an enlightening experience.

We had the opportunity to observe various production processes, particularly the Sulphuric Acid Plant. The expert operators at the factory explained each step-in detail, including how Sulphur dioxide created by exposing Sulphur Granules to humid air is later converted into Sulphur Trioxide by adding Vanadium Pentoxide as a catalyst over and over and over so that harmful emissions are minimised. They emphasised on the temperature requirements of each stage and how it is achieved using the huge array of equipments, including the various towers,

turbines, coolers and and furnaces. The operators also elucidated on the Contact process, where Sulphur Trioxide gas reacts with water to produce concentrated Sulphuric Acid and Oleum. Both of these products are used as raw materials for the manufacture of Ammonium Sulphate and Caprolactam respectively.

The emphasis on safety was evident throughout the visit. We received a detailed briefing on the safety measures implemented in the factory, including the use of personal protective equipment and emergency response protocols.

We also got to see FACT's strong emphasis on environmental sustainability. The operators placed emphasis on the impact of Environmental laws applicable to the factory, including measures taken to restrict SO2 emissions to 1200 ppm., and how FACT goes beyond them to meet its environmental responsibilities. We explored the eco-friendly initiatives adopted by the factory, such as waste management, recycling, and energy conservation. The interactive session also allowed us to engage in meaningful discussions, ,ask questions, and gain insights the challenges and innovations in the chemical industry.

The industrial visit to The Fertilisers and Chemicals Travancore Limited (FACT) was an enriching experience. The visit bridged the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application. Seeing concepts from our textbooks come to life was a valuable experience. We developed a heightened awareness of the importance of safety, quality control, and environmental sustainability in the chemical industry.

We extend our gratitude to ICAI Ernakulam and the Ernakulam Branch of SICASA of ICAI for organizing this insightful trip.
